

## Family Promise of Metro East Board of Directors Job Description

Family Promise of Metro East (FPME) is a local nonprofit organization working to help families in NE and SE Portland experiencing housing instability achieve sustainable independence through a community-based response.

FPME's Board of Directors is responsible for ensuring we effectively deliver on our mission and promise to families, our community, and our partners. We are a working Board of Directors, actively volunteering to launch the organization by bringing our unique skills, talents and passion for the mission to the role.

## The Board of Directors responsibilities include:

- Attend all board meetings, relevant committee meetings and functions, such as special events. The Board meets in person monthly (2nd Monday of the month at 6:30 pm).
- Advocate for Family Promise by becoming familiar with the organization and its mission, the activities of the organization, and the organizational structure.
- Review agendas and supporting materials prior to each board and committee meeting.
- Select the Executive Director and oversee their performance.
- Bring your skills to the work. Serve on committee(s) that speak to your interest and skill sets and offer to take on special assignments.
- Be a champion of the organization and inform others about Family Promise.
- Assist in fundraising. Make an annual financial contribution of personal significance and invite others to do the same. Promote fundraising events through personal channels and social media.
- Commit to advancing FPME's Diversity, Equity and Inclusion goals. Actively participate in DEI training and be accountable for your words and actions.
- Assist the Board in carrying out its fiduciary responsibilities. If needed, gain a basic working knowledge of the main tax laws that affect charities (e.g., Section 501(c)(3)).
- Follow all conflict of interest and confidentiality policies.
- Maintain trust in FPME by ensuring that donated funds are used for the purposes for which they were committed to fulfill the organization's mission.
- Participate in the Board's annual evaluation and planning efforts.

FPME Board Members serve a three-year, renewable term.
